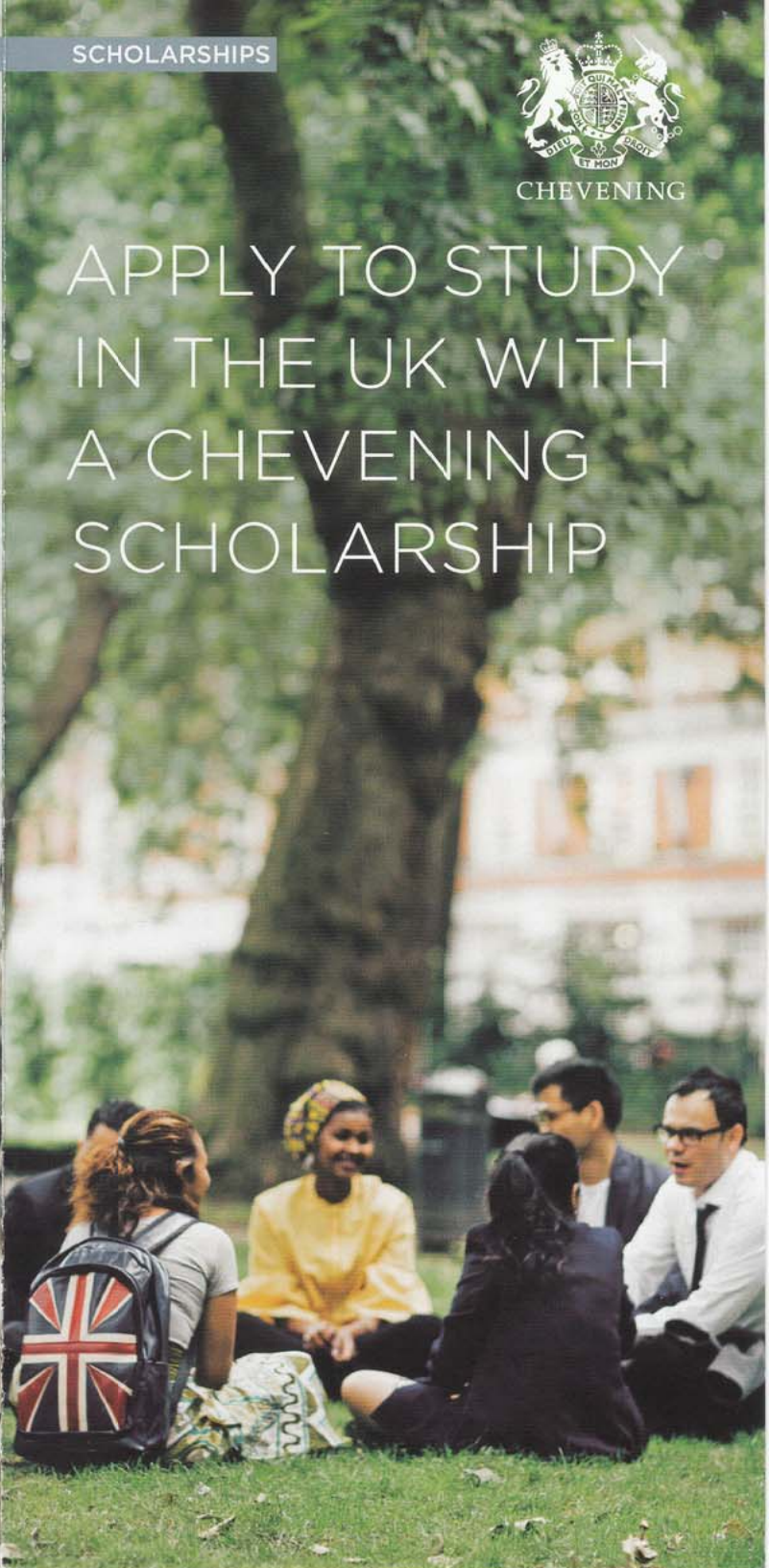

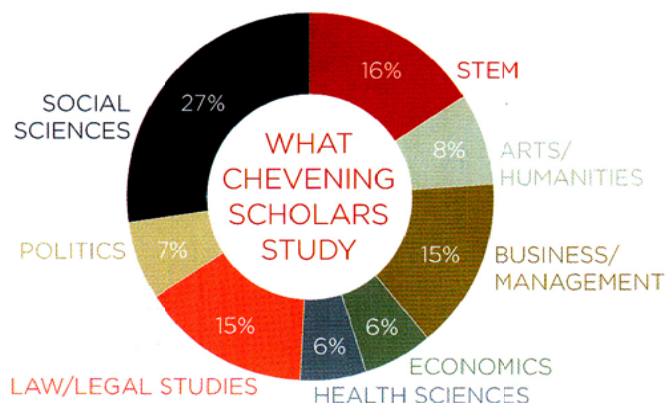
WHAT IS CHEVENING?

Chevening Scholarships is the UK government's global scholarship programme that offers future leaders the unique opportunity to study in the UK.

Funded by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) and partner organisations, these scholarships enable outstanding emerging leaders from over 160 countries and territories to pursue one-year master's degrees in any subject at any UK university.

Chevening Scholars have ambition, leadership potential, a strong academic background, and an excellent record of rising to prominent positions in their countries across a range of fields.

WHY APPLY?

Chevening provides fully-funded scholarships, leaving you free to focus on achieving your professional goals and enjoying the experience of a lifetime.

You will live and study in the UK for a year, during which time you will develop professionally and academically, network extensively, experience UK culture, and build lasting positive relationships with the UK.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

In order to submit an eligible Chevening Scholarship application, you must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country, and agree to return there for a minimum of two years after completing your scholarship.
- Have completed an undergraduate degree that will enable you to gain entry to a postgraduate programme at a UK university.
- Have at least two years' work experience.
- Not have previously studied in the UK with funding from a UK Government-funded scholarship.

There is no upper age limit.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

early
2018

All candidates are informed of the status of their applications. The strongest candidates are interviewed.

mid
2018

Interviewed candidates are notified of whether they have been conditionally selected, are on a reserve list, or are not being progressed.

July
2018

Selected and reserve candidates must have received an unconditional offer for at least one of their three master's course choices and must have met Chevening's English language requirement to remain eligible.

Sept
-Oct
2018

Successful applicants commence their studies in the UK as Chevening Scholars.

PROFILE OF A SCHOLAR



Kizanne was selected for a Chevening Scholarship as she embodies the qualities the programme seeks – leadership potential, strong networking skills, an understanding of the UK, and a strong career plan.

Kizanne, a doctor, has already been active in her community, working on issues of reproductive health and rights, youth leadership, and community development. She is now studying at the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Southampton.

Not only has she been tackling social issues in her home country, like many of our scholars she has had to overcome personal challenges and make bold life decisions before coming to the UK.

However, since settling on the south coast of England, Kizanne has made a huge impression. Her influence on campus was recognised when she won her university's Women in Science Engineering and Technology Award.
